These fake emails typically ask for money in the form of a gift card. This email scam has hit multiple UMC congregations in Michigan & within other conferences as well.

Congregations should be warned to be very careful on how they reply. We recommend pastors send a message to all their congregants to read their emails carefully & know that the church will NEVER send an appeal for money or gift cards by email. If a congregant receives a suspicious email they should always check with the pastor or church office by phone or in person before sending money, buying gift cards, or providing personal information.

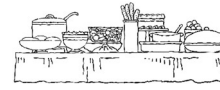
